Many people released from the camps have found their way to the Mannar and Mankulum districts. Mannar is an area which has been largely unaffected by the war. Mankulum is the town closest to Mullaitivu and people are encouraged to settle here, away from Mullaitivu, as Mullaitivu is still a highly restricted area. However, there is one problem with Mankulum.

Mankulum is under developed and there is no infrastructure present to support the people in their daily lives. As a result, ACF is trying to do all that is possible to help this area. ACF has started a large project to help up to 150 families with children. With the help of our Patron, Fr. James Pathinathan, we have managed to select 50 children who need immediate help. Most of these children have lost one or both parents.

The Indian connection

In our last newsletter we told you about our new project in the Annaiyur Camp, Madurai. Most people in this camp were displaced from Mannar and Trincomalee.

We are setting up learning centres to help them. These centres will be run by the "Mother Mary Education Trust" based in Dindugull, Tamil Nadu. This organisation is registered with the Indian authorities and has a licence to help 100 children in the camp.

We are building our own children's home in Mannar. It is nearing completion and is a three storey building capable of housing up to 100 children. Some of the funds from our sponsorship scheme have been diverted (with the sponsors' permission) in order to fund this project. So far, the cost is £35,000; however, the total cost may eventually exceed £55,000.
