Outcome of Flood Relief

Communities in Batticaloa, Amparai, Kilinochchi, Mannar and Mullaitivu had to face severe flooding once again. With your kind donations the results have made big changes.

ACF have allocated £5,000 to assist with the Church of American Ceylon Mission in East Sri Lanka with housing displaced people and provide urgent relief and support to the communities. Another £5,000 has helped 425 families in Mankulam and a further 131 families in neighbouring villages. Furthermore, £5,000 has helped many of the 1,425 families who were displaced and aided them in returning home and restarting their lives.
