### **Rebuilding Arobanam Boys Home**

Arobanam Boys Home was set up in Kilinochchi, Sri Lanka and was the first Home ACF supported and essentially where our work began. Even our charity's name was derived from this Home. The original Home housed 135/40 children from impoverished backgrounds and children who had lost their parents or families in the conflict.

Unfortunately, the Home was severely damaged by bombings and shell attacks in early 2009 and had to be shut down. The children that were able to escape became displaced. Over the last few years we have tirelessly worked to locate the missing children; later we found some have gone to other homes. We can now report that, following the government's approval to reopen Arobanam Boys Home, we now have 30 new children in the home supported by our contingency fund.

Further, the Home itself requires considerable rebuilding. The main dormitory needs a new roof and extensive repair work. If this is achieved, it will enable more children to be accommodated. So with your help we can restore Arobanam Boys Home to its former glory and provide a safe, healthy environment for the children to live and receive the education to secure their future.
