## A Special Night of Celebration!

Our "20 Year Journey Update & Charity Dinner" was held on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2015 at Oakington Manor School in Wembley, Middlesex, UK.

Our patron, Rev. Fr James Pathinathan graced this very special occasion together with ACF's present & passed members, sponsors and supporters.

Special effort was taken to highlight our 20 years of work, with the destitute children, through a gallery of photos that depicted important events in each year of its existence. Personal letters and artwork from the children were on display. In addition all female committee members wore blue stonework sarees (purchased by the members) that had been hand decorated by the children in Mankulam as part of their handy-craft project.



As in all our annual events, the programme started with the traditional lighting of the "kuththu vilakku" and the observance of a minute silence in respect of all who lost their lives in the Sri Lankan civil war.

The chairman, in his speech, took the audience through from ACF-UK's inception to its current status. In the main, it covered the reason for raising £1,200, through its first hat collection, twenty years ago (to support the then Long's Institute, which is now currently Arobanam Boys Home in Kilinocchi) to how it has evolved to today's structured approach of raising funds through its sponsorship and foster care schemes and special fund-raising events .

Committee members presented details of ACF's current state and future needs via a sketch video and slide presentations and highlighted the urgent need to find sponsors in order to ensure that support for our children is maintained for as long as there is a need. At present 232 children are supported through our contingency funds.

Our patron Fr James Pathinathan stated in his keynote speech that although Sri Lanka has undergone many constructional developments in recent times and given itself a "facelift" (whilst giving the impression that all is well with the country and its people), it should not deflect us from the important task that still remains: caring for the basic needs of the parentless children. He appealed to the UK community to help close the shortfall in sponsors by taking on new sponsorships. Furthermore, he emphasized that there are more than 80,000 female headed families currently struggling in the North and East of Sri Lanka.



Following our popular raffle draw the main part of our evening was rounded off with a delicious traditional Tamil dinner.

Excellent live entertainment was provided by vocalist Rachael Rajan and saxophonist Praveena Ravindrakumar.



Your contribution and support has so far enabled us to achieve the following:

- Invest approximately £1.5 million to support the children's needs
- Assist 642 children with their day-to-day needs (including 7 day care centres with 142 infants)
- Produce 28 university graduates (including a lawyer)
- Produce a successful singer/musician (released her first CD in Sri Lanka in 2014)
- Assist 14 university students on courses (including Engineering and Management Degrees)
- Set up building projects to renovate children's homes in need of urgent repair
- Distribute bicycles to provide urgent transport to school
- Provide milk, on a daily basis, for children under 12 years at Mahadeva Ashram in Kilinochchi
- Set up emergency relief appeals, such as Tsunami 2004, food parcel distributions in 2009, flood disaster to name a few.

As you may recall from our December newsletter, Arobanam Boys Home, set up in Kilinochchi, Sri Lanka was severely damaged by bombings and shell attacks in early 2009 and had to be shut down, with many of the staff and children missing in action.

Although we have recently reopened the Home, it requires substantial rebuilding. The Home has the potential to accommodate over 130 children however, due to the damage, only 30 boys are presently able to live here in a small area that has been restored. With your help, we can rebuild this Home to its former glory and enable it to operate at maximum capacity.
