**URGENT APPEAL: Funds needed for Sri Lanka & South India to help recover from heavy cyclones and rain** In the latter part of November and early December, Sri Lanka and Southern India have been badly hit by heavy cyclones and floods. This has caused much disruption to daily life to include damage of buildings, surrounding areas and vegetation. We expect the recovery period to take several weeks. It is also anticipated that further cyclones are expected between now and the New Year.

To date the worst affected of our partners is Good Shepherds Welcome Home in Anaikottai, which is a refuge to provide shelter, food and care to abused young women. The roof and floor of the building where they prepare food has been severely damaged, requiring us to fund repairs urgently. See below for latest pictures of the disruption.

ACF is setting up this urgent appeal to support with recovery of needs right now and in anticipation of further damage. Given that heavy rainfall and cyclones are a frequent occurrence in this area we will also consider using these funds to reinforce buildings and strengthen foundations.
