As you may be aware, ACF launched a new endeavour in December 2016 by partnering with ASSETS, an organisation providing assistance and resources to children with disabilities in Kilinochchi and the surrounding areas. Over the course of the last few months we have funded a furniture project to provide beds, clothes racks and mosquito nets to all the children currently occupied at the Hostel.



ACF identified that the Hostel initially lacked basic amenities with the children sleeping on mats on the floor. Following our furniture project, all our children were given beds and other furniture to promote a suitable living.
